**"Outokumpu: Finland's Calumet"
Artist Talk with Daniel Schneider
Wednesday, February 21 @ 6pm**

Local book artist Daniel Schneider spent September and October of last year as an artist and researcher in residence at the Vanha Kaivos (Old Mine) in Outokumpu, Finland. For much of the 20th century, Outokumpu was the center of copper mining in Finland. Daniel will talk about parallels between Finland's historic copper mines and the mining heritage here in Michigan's Copper Country, as well as talk about ways he uses industrial archaeology of mining in his book arts practice. **Free program.**

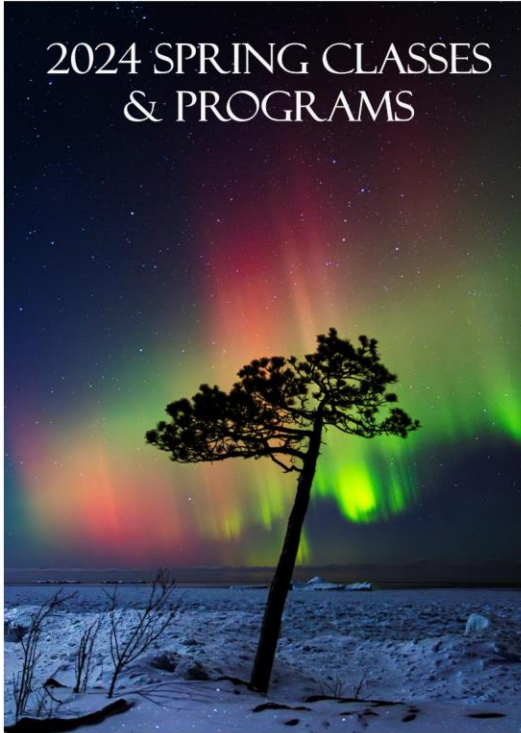
