**20 Photographs: Land and Sea by Jerry Basierbe**

Jerry Basierbe was born in Detroit and grew up in southeast Michigan. His fascination with photography began at an early age when he was given an inexpensive camera and some film as a gift. In the mid 1990s he became serious about photography and began taking classes at Oakland Community College. He has taken workshops with notable photographers such as Howard Bond and John Sexton, Ansel Adams' former assistant. Jerry's photographs are primarily of seascapes and landscapes. He prefers to photograph in low light situations, before sunrise or after sunset in order to utilize long exposure techniques. He also likes to photograph in less than ideal weather conditions. His work has been shown in many group and solo photography exhibitions in Detroit and southeastern Michigan as well as several exhibitions around the United States. Jerry lives in Livonia, Michigan and has worked at Ford Motor Company as a designer since 1990.

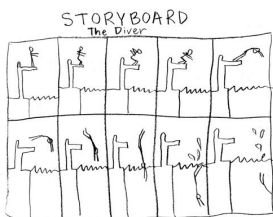
