ELIGIBILITY: All artists and craftspersons in any media who make their own ORIGINAL work. Prints must be of the exhibiting artist's work only. Clothing, fiber, and needlework must be designed by the artist. Ready-made pieces decorated by the artist are acceptable. It is unacceptable to use copies of other artists' paintings, photographs, greeting cards or magazine photos, kits, mold made or cast ceramics, commercial greeting cards, commercial settings for jewelry, or commercial patterns. Artists exhibiting works that do not meet these guidelines will be disqualified from future Poor Artists Sales. The committee reserves the right to make final decisions on entries. It will be a big day in Calumet as Calumet Celebrates the Arts! Don't miss your chance to be part of the biggest holiday shopping event in the Copper Country!

LOCATION: Calumet Public School Gymnasium on Calumet Avenue (US 41) in Calumet.

DATE & HOURS: Saturday, December 4, 2010 from 10 am to 4 pm. The show opens at 10am for members of the Copper Country Community Arts Council and 11am for the general public. We advertise that we will be there until 4 pm. Please do not start packing up early.

SET UP: Artists may start setting up from 9:30-11pm on Friday night. The building will be open at 8:00am on Saturday. All exhibitors must be set up by 9:45am the day of the sale. Complimentary coffee and home baked sweets will be available to exhibitors during set up on Saturday morning.

ENTRY DETAILS: THE BOOTH FEE IS \$65. THE DEADLINE IS OCTOBER 15, 2010. Please select the category you will be exhibiting in. The show will be juried by the committee. Originality and quality of the work as well as balance of mediums represented will be of primary consideration. Artists represented by the Community Arts Center are not required to submit samples of work. ALL OTHER ARTISTS MUST SEND PHOTOS REPRESENTATIVE OF THE WORK TO BE CONSIDERED WITH THEIR ENTRY FORM! PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT ACTUAL ARTWORK. Incomplete entries will not be considered. No transferred entries. A waiting list of individuals who have submitted a complete application within the deadline will be kept in the event of any cancellations. Notification will be sent October 21. No refunds after November 15.

DISPLAY: Booth spaces are 7' deep by 10' across. A larger space is available for artists using wheelchairs. Artists must bring their own display materials. The school will not have tables available. If you require electricity please note on entry form. You will be responsible for extension cords and duct tape to safely secure electrical cords. Artists' booths must be attended at all times. The CCCAC will provide relief people for artists coming alone. All work must be clearly marked with the price. Exhibitors are responsible for their own Michigan sales tax.

LUNCH? CCCAC members will be making a lunch for purchase as a fundraiser for the Community Arts Center. Please note on your application if you would like a lunch and whether you prefer vegetarian or not.

BEST BOOTH AWARDS! Beautiful or interesting booth displays draw more shoppers. If that's not incentive enough, how about free entry in to next year's sale, dinner for two, or nice prizes from local businesses? We will have a team of judges selecting awardees.
