


Seasons Greetings

6x6 Fundraiser

Letterpress, Books, & CCCAC Merchandise Shop

In February 2012 we celebrated the opening of our Letterpress Studio which was long in the making. When we received the original donation of the letterpress and bookbinding shop from Brian Johnson in December 1999 we had no home for it, so it stayed in storage for many years. Even when we started to move the equipment into our building, our knowledge of the machines, tools, and materials was limited. With Bonnie Loukus' and Dan Schneider's perseverance and dedication to the project, they both have cultivated a solid knowledge of letterpress printing. Bonnie has developed the Book Arts Camp for youth and Dan has taught a number of introductory classes for adults and provided public demonstrations. Our next step time is to focus on developing a line of products that we can sell in the gallery to increase revenue and continue to foster the appreciation of the craft of letterpress printing. The Community Arts Center will be closed to the public for the month of January, which will enable us to go into full production. We will be designing and printing a line of letterpress products for sale to benefit the CCCAC including multiple note card designs, small hand bound blank journals and notebooks, posters, and gift items. **When we reopen in February you will be able to visit our shop in the Sales Gallery!**


