Recent work by Christine Hagedorn Kerredge Gallery September 8-30, 2021

Christine Hagadorn makes sculpture in mixed media which mostly includes paper, wood, and string. She "weathers" her materials so they look old and used, simulating the patina of touch, the residue of history. The act of stitching is important in her work. She says, "I came to it without thinking at all but I believe it is the voices of women." The exhibition is a mix of ethereal boat shaped forms and shields as well as two dimensional pieces featuring found objects and "impossible" books.

In her artist statement, Christine says, "I am interested in the spirituality of other cultures, particularly how spiritual belief is imbued with magic and protection. I have been creating items of spiritual significance for myself and my community. I have made these pieces with thoughts of magic and the spirit of protecting so that our losses can be soothed. So that we can go on to be our best selves." Christine earned her MFA in sculpture from Eastern Michigan University and her BFA in printmaking from Wayne State University.

MINIGRANTS The Regional Re-granting program includes grants for schools, Arts Equipment & Supplies Grants for up to \$1500 and Bus Grants for up to \$500 for activities taking place between October 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022. Applicants must be an accredited Michigan preK-12 educational institution, public or non-public school, private school, home school, school district, intermediate school district/regional educational service agency or an accredited Head Start program. There is an open deadline through April 16, 2022 (or until all funds have been expended.) Grants are awarded on a first come, first served basis.
