# Finns Love Alliteration New work by Lenore Rae Lampi Kerredge Gallery August 3-31

Duluth artist Lenore Rae Lampi is well known for her functional birchbark pottery. She has mastered the various colors and textures of birch trees that are so prevalent here. Her bowls, vases, and mugs range in color from matte

white to amber and bronze. Some bear decorative knot holes and curls. Her work explores the possibilities of form and movement as well as notions of strength, endurance, and subtlety.

Lenore Lampi earned her BA degree in Fine Arts from University of Minnesota, Duluth and her MA in Art Education from University of Minnesota, Minneapolis. She has had exhibitions throughout the midwest, at SOFA in Chicago, and in Helsinki and Seinajoki, Finland. This exhibition, "Finns Love Alliteration" will feature Lenore's sculptural work which includes wall mounted birch bark curls, lily pads, and water as well as her birchbark inspired functional ware. Join us for an opening reception and gallery talk on Thursday, August 3 from 6-7:30pm.



# UP Poet Laureate Reading and Book Signing Thursday, August 17 from 5:30-7:30pm

We are pleased to host Beverly Matherne, Poet Laureate of the Upper Peninsula on Thursday, August 17 from 5:30-7:30pm. Beverly will be in the gallery at 5:30 for a book signing and the program will start at 6:00 where she will read from her most recent book of poems and short short fiction titled, Potions d'amour, thés, incantations Love Potions, Teas, Incantations

along with a slide presentation of the works of art that inspired the collection.

Born in St. James Parish, she is inspired by her Cajun and Creole heritage. Her mother was a poet and her father sang in Cajun French and recited Shake-speare's soliloquies in English. Her newest set of poems and stories are set in and around New Orleans. Beverly Matherne holds a PhD in Drama from Saint Louis University and MA and BA degrees in English from the University of Lousiana at Lafayette. She is Professor Emerita of English at Northern Michigan University where she served as director of the Master of Fine Arts program in creative writing.

### Selections from the Permanent Collection Kerredge Gallery September 5-30, 2023

In 1998, the CCCAC's Board of Directors made the commitment to establish a permanent collection. It started with the purchase of original watercolors by Barbara Cloutier and Edith Marshall when we produced Art in the Garden posters. Over the years our collection has grown out of the interest and generosity of individuals. Many of the works have been donated by collectors, the artists' family members, or the artists themselves. Initially, our pursuit of building a permanent collection was about collecting art that depicted life here in this remote region and the mining history. The collection continues to grow and has expanded to represent the rich and diverse art of the region. This exhibition will include new works of art in the collection that have not been seen.
