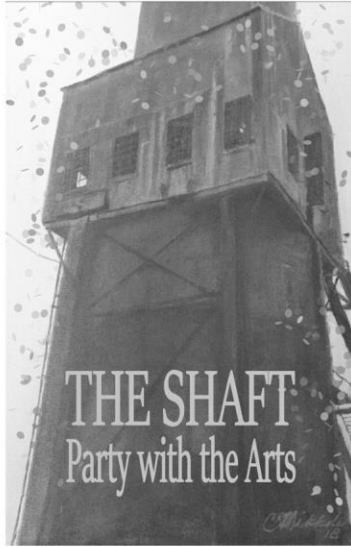

MCACA GRANT NEWS! The CCCAC was awarded a \$15,000 grant from the Michigan Council for Arts and Cultural Affairs for Operational Support. The grant was awarded through the MCACA peer review process ensuring people in Michigan have access to the highest quality arts and cultural experiences.

The CCCAC was awarded \$29,497 for Regional Regranting (minigrants) awards and \$10,000 for Administration of the Regional Regranting program. The CCCAC also received \$1500 for Professional and Organizational Development.
