Clay Class with Tammy Gajewski

**Saturdays, June 10, 17, & 24
from 10:30am-12:30pm**

In this class Tammy Gajewski will introduce students to the basics including preparing your clay, centering, attaching handles, how to make a lid, how to make sure pot has uniform thickness from base to top and the essentials for constructing a teapot. All pieces will be fired after the 24th. Pieces will be available for painting or students may sign up for the glazing class in August. 10lbs of clay and 10 hours of studio time included. Some clay experience suggested.

Kitchen-litho is a great DIY printmaking technique that uses safe materials readily available to create prints without chemicals or a printing press. The process is directly related to traditional stone lithography, mirroring the basic principles of the technique. Images can be created on a range of surfaces and the process can still create a traditional print edition as well. It's a great at-home printing process to have fun and experiment.

Learn techniques for rendering text and illustrations for zines using a variety of media: typewriters, letterpress, pen & ink, Letraset!

The class includes some basic letterpress type composition and printing images. Participants will leave the class with several sheets of letterpress printed images and alphabets for use in future zine work, a pack of Letraset dry transfer type, and finished zine paste-up sheets ready for publication. Class is geared for teens and adults.
